In April 2017 the GAMEO site had a total of 58,462 sessions/visits and 48,961 users/visitors (this compares with 37,802 sessions/visits and 31,493 users/visitors in December 2015). The number of pages visited per session was 1.85 (1.97 in 2015), and the average session duration was 1 minute and 41 seconds (1 minute and 54 seconds in 2015). The bounce rate (the percentage of visitors who enter the site and "bounce" [leave the site] rather than continue viewing other pages within the same site) was 75.74% (73.23% in 2015). 78.07% of the visitors were new visitors (75.26% in 2015), and 21.93% were returning visitors (24.74% in 2015).

A total of 107,919 pages were viewed in April 2017 (74,393 pages were viewed in December 2015). Of these, 45,035 were viewed for 10 seconds or less (28,532 in 2015). 3,505 were viewed for 1-3 minutes (8,738 in 2015), 3,438 were viewed for 3-10 minutes (11,915 in 2015), 2,456 were viewed for 10-30 minutes (11,430 in 2015), and 558 were viewed for more than 30 minutes (7,604 in 2015).

The GAMEO website uses Google Analytics to track website usage. A variety of statistics are compiled. The following are a sample of the types of statistics compiled:

Articles that consistently make the top 25 include those that we would expect, such as Menno Simons, Church of God in Christ, Mennonite, Beachy Amish Mennonite Fellowship, Old Order Amish, and Hutterian Brethren. In 2017, two Hutterite colonies made the top 25, and another 8 Hutterite colonies were listed in the top 100. The death of M.J. Sharp and the resulting article, written by Sam Steiner, resulted in an incredible 10,998 page views, comprising 10.19% of all page views for the month of April.

New Content

A total of 157 new articles were added to GAMEO from January to December 2016. This compares with a total of 200 new articles in 2015.

Devices

Over the past four years, an increasing percentage of those visiting the GAMEO site have done so using a mobile phone instead of a desktop computer. In 2013, three-quarters of our visitors used a desktop; in 2017, just under half used a desktop.
