In December 2015 the GAMEO site had a total of 37,802 sessions/visits and 31,493 users/visitors (this compares with 41,035 sessions/visits and 34,178 users/visitors in 2014). The number of pages visited per session was 1.97 (1.92 in 2014), and the average session duration was 1 minute and 54 seconds (1 minute and 50 seconds in 2014). The bounce rate (the percentage of visitors who enter the site and "bounce" [leave the site] rather than continue viewing other pages within the same site) was 73.23% (73.76% in 2014). 75.26% of the visitors were new visitors (76.4% in 2014), and 24.74% were returning visitors (23.6% in 2014).

A total of 74,393 pages were viewed (78,845 pages in 2014). Of these, 28,532 were viewed for 10 seconds or less (31,283 in 2014). 8,738 were viewed for 1-3 minutes (9,367 in 2014), 11,915 were viewed for 3-10 minutes (12,360 in 2014), 11,430 were viewed for 10-30 minutes (12,210 in 2014), and 7,604 were viewed for more than 30 minutes (7,375 in 2014).

The GAMEO website uses Google Analytics to track website usage. A variety of statistics are compiled. The following are a sample of the types of statistics compiled:

Articles that consistently make the top 25 include those that we would expect, such as Menno Simons, Church of God in Christ, Mennonite, Beachy Amish Mennonite Fellowship, Old Order Amish, and Hutterian Brethren. In 2015, two Hutterite colonies made the top 25, and another 13 Hutterite colonies were listed in the top 100.

#### **New Content**

A total of 200 new articles were added to GAMEO from January to December 2015. This compares with a total of 277 new articles in 2014 and 634 new articles in 2013. Approximately 160 articles contributed in 2015 were by the managing editor and are basically "stub" congregational entries for some of the conservative Mennonite conferences in North America.

#### 2015 Activities

In July I attended the Mennonite World Conference in Pennsylvania. I set up a GAMEO display that included our roll-up display and a number of templates in several languages. John Roth and I gave a presentation on GAMEO and the Global Anabaptist Wiki, and I coordinated two other workshops focusing on archival and preservation topics.

The two managing editors took some time in 2014 to work through articles in GAMEO that originated with the Mennonite Encyclopedia. Sam completed his work with volume 1, and Richard worked through the first half of volume 2. Articles in need of revision or updating have been identified, and potential authors have been suggested for a number of these articles. Further work was not carried out in 2015, but I hope that we can pick it up again in 2016.

### **Editors**

Susan Huebert has continued to be active throughout the year, going through articles in GAMEO and correcting spelling and grammatical errors. Others have had limited activity in 2015.

## **Concluding Comments**

For the second year in a row, I have not had as much time as I have in the past for my work as Managing Editor. My work with the Mennonite Heritage Museum was fairly intense throughout 2015. Now that the Museum has opened, I anticipate a return to my previous volunteer loading.
